This week's Nursery Rhymes was Mary Had a Little Lamb. They picked out the rebus picture of the school right away. :) Keep on singing/saying your rhymes.



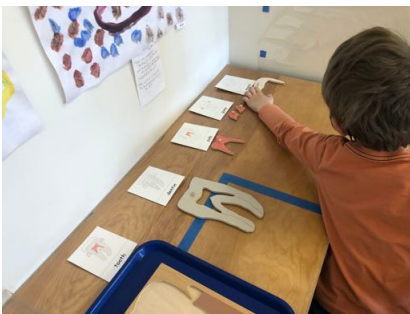
Different language works appeared on their shelves and they did a great job working through them.

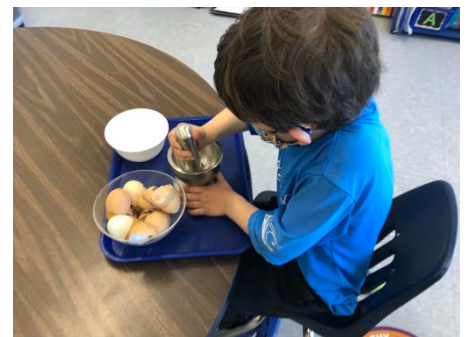
Ed Emberly drawing books are being shared with sanitizing required before handling. These have been favorites in past years.
